
General Order No. 271


This Order hereby supersedes and amends Sections A. 1. and 2. of General Order #185 entered May 14, 2004.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that out of the Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) collected from the Attorney Admissions Fee, that Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) will be deposited by the Clerk in the General Fund Receipt Account, One Hundred Fifty Six Dollars (\$156.00) will be deposited into the special Filing Fee Judiciary Fund established under 28 U.S.C § 1914, and Twenty Four Dollars (\$24.00) will be deposited into the District of Idaho Non-Appropriated Fund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the entire amount of the Two Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$225.00) collected from each verified petition of the Pro Hac Vice Fee be deposited into the District of Idaho Non-Appropriated Fund.
