
GENERAL ORDER NO. 62

The Court having considered the recommendations made by the Judicial Conference of the United States,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, under 21 USC 848(q)(10), the presumptive rate for compensation of counsel appointed pursuant to 21 USC 848(q) and 18 USC 3006A(a)(2)(B) shall be \$ ~~100.00~~ per hour for time expended in-court and out-of-court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this rate shall apply only to the portion of the services claimed in the attorney compensation claim which were performed on or after April 1, 1990.
